2. Juniors use Junior Arts & Crafts entry forms. All information must be PRINTED except signature.
3. Each item must be listed separately and specifically on form.
4. Items listed in an "any other" class must be specified clearly on form, and must not be eligible for entry in any other class.
5. Entries must be original work of exhibitor. No kits allowed unless stated.
6. Entries must have been completed within one year of the opening date of fair.
7. **Every possible care will be taken in handling entries, but the fair assumes no responsibility for loss or damage from any cause to any item entered.** All State & Local rules apply. All General Rules at the front of this handbook apply.

4. Items listed in an "any other" class must be specified clearly on form, and must not be eligible for entry in any other class.
5. Entries must be original work of exhibitor. No kits allowed unless stated. Entries must have been completed within one year of the opening date of fair. **Every possible care will be taken in handling work, but the fair assumes no responsibility for loss or damage from any cause to any item entered.**
6. All State & Local rules apply (see front of Exhibitor Handbook).

Additional Rules for Sr. Fine Art

1. Works must be framed, ready to hang, with screw eyes and wire attached.
2. Limit: 1 entry per exhibitor per class. No more than 3 total entries per exhibitor. Paintings are not to exceed 4' x 4', including frame.
3. In classes which require that the exhibit be the creative work of the owner, husband & wife are considered separate exhibitors.
4. Any exhibitor that teaches or sells their work for profit must enter in the professional divisions.
5. *Entry Fee: Amateur, none; Professional, \$4.00 per entry.* Any exhibitor that teaches or sells their work for profit must enter professional.
