Record Books for 4-H Exhibitors are not required to be turned in to the Livestock office, but **MUST** be brought to the scheduled interview and can be picked up in the Livestock Office after the completion of judging.

- 2) A Two-page story including how and why the project was started, how it is financed, problems encountered and resolved, size and scope of project and any future plans they may have for their projects.
- 3) Form B-Leave this section blank and turn back in with application. A 4-H/FFA or Fair representative will do all calculations of placing records for placing points.
