REQUIRMENTS

1. Applicants must be a graduating Senior (class of 2017) attending college or a vocational school in the fall of 2017 or a 2016 graduate.
2. Must be a Full Time Student with 12 or more credits.
3. You may only be awarded the scholarship one time.
4. Applications for the 2017 Founding Fathers Scholarship will be due to the Dairy Clerk in the Stanislaus County Fair Livestock Office by Thursday July 13, 2017 by 3:00p.m.
5. Applicants will be required to go through an interview the morning of Friday, July 14, 2017. Applicants interviewing in both Outstanding Exhibitor and Scholarship interviews will be accommodated accordingly.
6. If awarded a scholarship, please provide proof of enrollment when available.

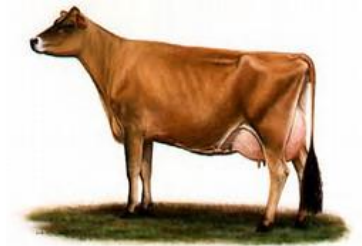
