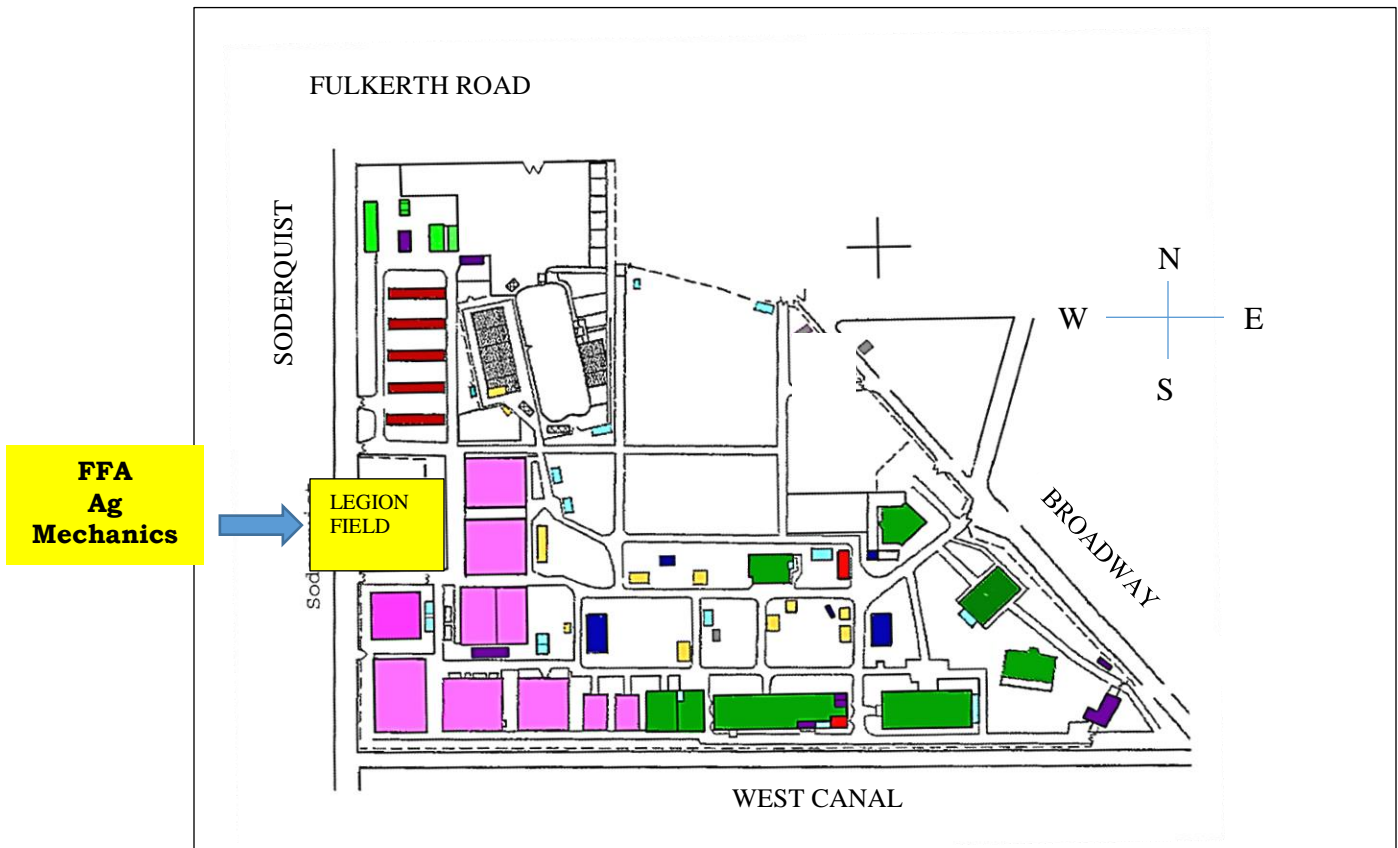

FFA AG MECHANICS RULES

1. Entries are due by **Thursday, May 18th**. Enter online at www.stancofair.com **All entries submitted on a paper entry form will be charged a \$4.00 processing fee per Exhibitor.**
2. Entries must be the exhibitor's project in Ag Mechanics for the past year.
3. Participation at the fair is limited to the following rules:
 - a) Exhibitors must reside in the 38th Agricultural District, composed of Stanislaus County and that portion of Merced County north of the Merced River served by the Turlock Irrigation District.
 - b) San Joaquin County 4-H Clubs or FFA Chapters may be eligible to enter in the FFA Ag Mechanics Department divisions only if the requirement of 50% or more of the total Exhibitors in a Club or Chapter reside within Stanislaus County.
 - c) Verification of residence within Stanislaus County is subject to review each year to qualify for participation at the Stanislaus County Fair
4. The exhibitor must be the major contributor to the construction or repair of the entry.
5. Entries may not be shown more than one calendar year, from. **NOTE: Any project shown at any State, County or District Fair must be shown within the same calendar year.**
6. LIMIT: 2 entries per same pattern. Exhibitors are not allowed to enter more than two identical/similar items for any entry into fair, (design should not be reproduced by the same student 3 times and entered 3 times).
7. **All projects that do not receive a placing of 1st or 2nd MUST be picked up on Thursday, July 13th between 8 a.m. and 1 p.m. or they will be discarded. Only 1st and 2nd place exhibits will be displayed during the fair.**
8. Yellow display cards must be filled out (for medium & large projects) and attached to each entry and must include correct labeling of the exhibit, and a brief summary of the project.
9. **DRAWING PROJECTS:** Exhibitors that do not follow the entry instructions as stated, will not be judged or displayed and will be disqualified. No refunds on disqualified entries. ALL drawings must be neatly fastened to foam board.
10. **GROUP PROJECT: Entered by school/chapter.** Student names must be listed on each entry. This is for projects involving 2-6 students. One poster board display is required per project (Minimum 27"x30"), and must include 6 pictures (Minimum 8"x10") showing students working on the project during the process of construction and must include the receipts or an expense list. **Limit 4 per school.**
11. **SCHOOL/GROUP PROJECT AUCTION ITEMS:** Entered by school/chapter, student's names listed on each entry. This is for projects involving 2-6 students. One poster board display is required per project (min. 27" x 30") and must include 6 pictures (min. 8" x 10") showing students working on the project during the process of construction plus include the receipts or an expense list. If a School/Group decides to sell their project at auction, it must be entered in **BOTH** the Auction **AND** Division by the entry deadline.
12. **INDIVIDUAL AUCTION ITEMS:** Entered by student, school name included on each entry. This is for projects involving individual students. One poster board display is required per project (min. 27" x 30") and must include 6 pictures (min. 8" x 10") showing the student working on the project during the process of construction plus include the receipts or an expense list. Material cost on item should not exceed \$40.00. If an Individual decides to sell their project at auction, it must be entered in **BOTH** the Auction **AND** Division by the entry deadline.

FFA CHAPTER GROUP

1. Projects must be entered in the FFA Ag Mechanics department
 2. FFA Chapter must designate 5 projects
 3. FFA Chapter must confirm projects for Chapter Group on the receiving date for entries.

DRAWING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Two divisions are available based on the mode of development either computer generated or hand drawn.
2. Students must choose between one of three areas of interest. These areas include:
 - a. Technical.
 - b. 3-D Perspective Views. 3-D Perspective views would include drawings that are given depth and dimension, such as blocks, projects and equipment.
 - c. Equipment and Shapes. Equipment design would demonstrate flat views of floor plans for buildings, landscapes, equipment and projects.
3. All drawings must be completed on 11x17 paper and include information about the drawing. Drawings must be mounted and no larger than 12x18.

AUCTION RULES

1. Exhibitor must be enrolled in a school vocational class and currently in good standing as an FFA member. Refer to general rule #3 for Exhibitor eligibility.
2. Only project exhibits earning a first-place award will be eligible for sale at auction
3. No premiums will be paid for projects sold through the auction
4. Exhibitors must include a minimum bid with their entry, based on the value of the project.
5. A 5% commission will be charged to the exhibitor for all projects sold through the auction.
6. If a School/Group or Individual decides to sell their project at auction, it must be entered in BOTH the Auction AND Division by the entry deadline.
