SENIOR DEPARTMENT RULES FOR PRESERVED FOODS

1. Limit: **One entry per exhibitor per class.**
2. All products considered for cash awards, which have not been eliminated from consideration, may be opened.
3. Use standard canning jar suitable for your entry. **Must be sealed with lid and ring -NO PARAFFIN.**
4. Preserved food exhibitors must submit two (2) jars per entry. One will be opened for judging and the other will be used for display. **All open jars must be picked up on Wednesday, July 19th from 8 a.m. – 10 a.m. (Bring claim check)**
7. LABEL ALL ENTRIES WITH NAME OF PRODUCT AND CONTENT.
8. DEFINITIONS: **BUTTER:** Sieved or processed fruit pulp cooked to a thick smooth consistency which will spread easily. Spices may be added. **CONSERVE:** Similar to marmalade, made with 2 or more fruits. Nuts and raisins are usually used, but are not required. **JAM:** A preserve that is cooked until it is pulp. **MARMALADES:** Use fruits that have jellying properties containing slices, small pieces or peel of the fruits in the jelly. **JELLY** should be clear. **PRESERVES:** Whole fruit or uniform pieces of the fruit cooked slowly so that the pieces retain their shape and do not become pulp. **RELISH:** Prepared from fruit and/or vegetables that are chopped, seasoned, and then cooked to desired consistency. **STANDARD CANNING JAR:** Glass container specifically designed for canning. **NON-ACID FOODS:** All vegetables, meats, poultry and fish must be canned under pressure. **LOW-ACID FRUIT,** such as figs, should be made more acidic by adding lemon juice, as directed in the University Agriculture Extension Service leaflet "Home Canning of Fruits." Tomatoes and fruits (including their juices) must be processed in a boiling water bath.
