Exhibits (entries) must be an integral part of their supervised 4-H project. Exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H project in which they are entering.

<b><u>Intermediate:</u></b>	3 <sup>rd</sup> or 4 <sup>th</sup> year project
<b><u>Advanced:</u></b>	5 <sup>th</sup> year & over project

**4-H MEDALS OF MERIT** will be awarded to the winners earning the highest total points in Beginning, Intermediate & Advanced divisions in Entomology, Wildlife, Automotive, Tractors, Small Engines, Electric, Woodworking, Photography, Rocketry, Fine Arts and Crafts, Clothing, Home Furnishings, Baked Foods, Decorated Cakes, Canning and Drying. Group classes are not included. Outstanding exhibits are recognized as **BEST OF SHOW**.

Points are earned as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> = 5 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 1 point

## **4-H BAKED FOOD**

### **RULES FOR BAKED FOODS:**

1. Each entry submitted **MUST** be from a different recipe.
2. Foods that require refrigeration may not be entered.
3. Minimum quantities required per entry: Bread: ½ loaf (approx. size 5"x 9"). Cakes: ½ plus one slice. Pies: 1 pie. Candies & Cookies: 3 pieces. Muffins & Rolls: 3 pieces. Any other: 2-3 pieces
4. Entries must be submitted on a disposable plate. All baked foods will be disposed of.

4. Theme, shape, and technique of entries must be listed.
5. Disposable cake boards should be wrapped with white paper covered with plastic wrap.

### **RULES FOR PRESERVED-DRIED FOODS**

1. Low acid foods must be canned under pressure, sealed with rings and no paraffin
2. Preserved Foods Exhibitors MUST SUBMIT TWO (2) JARS PER ENTRY.  
One will be opened for judging, and one will be used for display.
3. All open jars must be picked up on Thursday, July 13 from 8 a.m.-10 a.m.  
**(bring claim check)**. Unclaimed jars and contents will be disposed of.
4. Entries for Jerky must include 6 strips.
5. Entries for Dried Fruit must include 6 to 8 Sections.
6. Exhibitors entering dried Fruit and/or Vegetables in the above classes are not eligible to enter the same entries in the 4H Ag Hort Divisions.
