THE CENTRAL VALLEY’S FINEST LIVESTOCK TO BE SOLD AT THE FAIR!

Turlock, CA (July 12, 2017)– Only the best livestock will be sold this year for the County’s livestock auction at the Stanislaus County Fair.

Local bidders will have the chance to take home some of the finest livestock in the Central Valley at the Stanislaus County Fair’s **50th Annual Replacement Heifer Sale on Friday, July 14th**, the **53rd Annual Beef Sale on Friday, July 21st** and the **53rd Annual Junior Livestock Auction on Saturday, July 22nd** at the Stanislaus County Fairgrounds, located at 900 N. Broadway in Turlock.

Buyers may pre-register for the sales and auction at the Fair’s Livestock Office or Sales Office prior to the fair.

“The 4-H and FFA exhibitors take the upmost care for their animals all year and many of them use the money raised at the Heifer Sale, Beef Sale and Junior Livestock Auction for their college fund,” said Adrenna Alkhas, spokesperson for the Stanislaus County Fair. “I think bidders would find it difficult finding animals that are better fed and better cared for than those exhibited at the Stanislaus County Fair.”

Buyers are invited to the 50th Annual Replacement Heifer Sale on Friday, July 14, following the Heifer Preview, which begins at 6 p.m. in the Thurman Pavilion. The 53rd Annual Beef Sale on Friday, July 21st following the Beef Preview, which begins at 6 p.m. in the barns. You can also see the county’s finest rabbits, poultry, swine, sheep and goats at the 53rd Annual Junior Livestock Auction, Saturday, July 22nd at 8 a.m.

Catalogs for the 2017 Replacement Heifer Sale are available now in the Fair's Livestock Office. The Livestock Office is located on the Fairgrounds, near the Soderquist Road entrance. Catalogs for the Junior Livestock Auction will be available on the morning of the auction and will be distributed during bidder registration and check-in.

With over 1,500 4-H and FFA animals entered in the 2017 Stanislaus County Fair, this year's sale and auction are sure to produce an impressive roster of livestock.

The 2017 Stanislaus County Fair opens Friday, July 14th for a 10-day run. Fair guests can count on an award-winning experience that has been over 106 years in the making. Discounted Fair admission tickets, unlimited ride wristbands, and the Fair season pass are on sale now through Thursday, July 13, 2017. The 2017 Fair will feature a spectacular children's area presented by Sky Trek Aviation.
