

Check List for Insurance Certificate Requirements

Insurance Certificate – Must be a signed original certificate of insurance (the Acord form is acceptable).

List as Additional Insured – The following language must be used: "That the State of California, the District Agricultural Associations, Counties in which the fair is located, Lessor/Sublessor if fair site is leased/subleased, Citrus Fruit Fair, California Exposition and State Fair, or Entities (public or non-profit) operating California designated agricultural fairs, their agents, directors, officers, servants and employees are made additional insured, but only insofar as the operations under this contract are concerned."

Event Dates – The dates of the Fair (July 13th through July 22nd), including set-up dates (July 9th through July 12th) and take down dates (July 23th through July 24th).

Coverage - \$1,000,000 for other contracts for which liability insurance is required by the State of California; \$2,000,000 for amusement device contracts (including carnival, bungee cord jumping, Oribtrons and simulators).

Cancellation Notice – A statement by the insurance company that it will not cancel said policy or policies without giving **30 days** prior written notice to the named certificate holder.

Producer – Name and address of insurance agency.

Insured – Name and address of vendor; this should be the same name that is used on the contract.
