Turlock, CA (February 18, 2017) — The American Red Cross will open a shelter at the Stanislaus County Fairgrounds Turf Club building on Sunday, February 19, 2017 at 4 p.m.

According to Stanislaus County Office of Emergency Services (OES) they are continuing to monitor all the rivers and creeks in Stanislaus County.

“The fairgrounds facility is here to help shelter anyone affected with the floods,” said Matt Cranford, chief executive office of the Stanislaus County Fairgrounds. “We are working diligently with the Red Cross to assist our community and make sure residents have a place to shelter.”

To reach the fairgrounds Turf Club facility from hwy 99 take the Fulkerth exit; left on Fulkerth; then a right on Soderquist Rd. The facility is located on the left side of Soderquist.
