Subject: **2021 Stanislaus County Fair – Replacement Heifer Applications**

Replacement Heifer Sale on Sunday, July 11, 2021 in the Linhares Ring

ENTRY DEADLINE

Online entries will be open February 1st to February 23rd only.

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the correct division/class for their heifer entries, including showmanship and outstanding exhibitor divisions. **All heifer entries must be entered online and paid for prior to turning in your Replacement Heifer application.** Showmanship, outstanding exhibitor and exhibitor/parent/parking fair passes (if eligible) must be paid no later than midnight **Thursday, May 13th**. Please bring your receipt with you when turning in your Replacement Heifer paperwork. No paper entries will be accepted.

Exhibitors who do not submit complete heifer applications with all required information and documents by the deadline as stated, are subject to the extended deadline rule as follows:

Extended entry deadline: Tuesday, March 2, 2021, no later than 5:00 p.m.

*Exhibitors must call the fair office to schedule an appointment to submit extended deadline Heifer entries. Complete applications and entry forms, including all required information and documents, will only be accepted with a fee of \$250.00 (plus entry fees) and paid in full by **cash only**. Please call Kassi Sieber-Laughlin, Livestock Office Manager at (209) 632-2557 to schedule a time and date for an appointment. All appointments will be scheduled with Lori Marchy, Fair Representative.*

If 2 heifer entries are submitted by the deadline as stated. Exhibitors must designate which animal entry will be put into the Replacement Heifer Sale. Declaration must be submitted by signature of the Exhibitor (as per Livestock Fair Committee Rule) at the Fair's Livestock Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 17, 2021.

Replacement Heifer Entry Fee: \$15.00 per entry

Completed Applications, test records, pictures, entry forms and all required information must be submitted to the Livestock Office **via appointment only** on the following dates **ONLY**:

Monday, February 22nd from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (livestock office)

Tuesday, February 23rd from 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. (livestock office)

All Heifer applications must include DHIA test production records or complete private test record as specified and records must be within 1 year of the entry deadline as stated in the Exhibitor Handbook

1. Production Records – Either the Dam’s DHIA test records or a complete private test record will be accepted. (Please refer to the following production record specifications.)
 - A. The Dam’s DHIA test records can be one of the following.
 - i. The **Dam’s DHIA sheet** from **Agri-Tech Analytic** or **DHI Provo** (Please refer to enclosed Example 1)
 - ii. Or, a computer-generated copy of the **DHIA test records** from **Dairy Comp 305** or other computer programs. (**Please refer to Enclosed Example 2.**) These computer-generated test records must include the following **Heifer** and **Dam** information.

Heifer information including:

- a. Page 1 Events – from the computer program
- b. Page 2 from the computer program
- c. Page 5 Prev Lact (**Since Heifer is not milking, this gives the Dam’s Production Record from the computer program.** Note that all three pages can be printed on one page as shown on the front side of example 2.)

Dam information including:

- a. Page 1 Events – from the computer program
- b. Page 2 from the computer program
- c. Page 5 Prev Lact (**This gives the total Production Record of the Dam from the computer program.** Note that all three pages can be printed on one page as shown on backside of example 2.)

If private test records are used they must be complete. They must provide the same information as a computer-generated copy of DHIA test records. **Please refer to specifications above.**

HEIFER APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR ENTRY IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

- APPLICATION IS MISSING REQUIRED INFORMATION
 - INCORRECT INFORMATION
 - ENTRY DOES NOT MEET ALL THE REQUIREMENTS AS STATED IN THE HEIFER RULES
