## **GENERAL RULES**

1. Online entries must be completed by 12:00 (midnight), Thursday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. Enter online at [www.stancofair.com](http://www.stancofair.com). All 2021 State Rules for California apply.
2. Open to 4-H, FFA, Grange and Independent Exhibitors who meet the local 4-H, FFA, Grange and Independent specifications for entry in this department. 4-H, FFA and Grange exhibitors must be enrolled in the project for 60 days prior to the receiving date.
3. Management reserves the right to return entries when available facilities are filled.
4. All exhibitors must be in official uniform at time of showing and must bring their own animal to and from the show table for judging and must be present when their animal is judged. Contact superintendent concerning time conflicts.
5. The Fair will provide bedding for any species that is being sold in the Small Animal auction.
6. All exhibitors are expected to groom and care for their own animal(s) when at the fair. Exhibitors shall refrain from accepting active assistance from adults and non-exhibiting youth unless the junior exhibitor is actively engaged, and the assistance is only for instruction. The use of professional groomers will be cause for disqualification of the member and/or animals. Disqualification consists of withholding premium money and ribbons, elimination from further competition and/or removal from the auction. The intent of this rule is for junior exhibitors to work on their own animals.
7. Animals will be shown & judged in the proper division, class, variety, age & sex.
8. The Stanislaus County Fair is not responsible for loss, death, or injury of any animals. All possible care will be taken to protect all animals.
9. All Small Animal shows will be a one day carrying cage show. Animals can leave when the show is over.
10. All awards must be picked up at close of show, they will not be mailed. All premiums mailed.
11. The scales used for determination of weight are to be provided by the Stanislaus County Fair only.
12. All State and Local rules apply.

## **RABBIT DEPARTMENT RULES:**

1. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as described in the latest edition of the Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. American Rabbit Breeders Association, Eric Stewart, Executive Director, P.O. Box 400, Knox, Pennsylvania 16232. Stanislaus County Fair rules may supersede A.R.B.A. rules where matters of policy or procedures are involved. **A.R.B.A. age rule does apply. If you turn 19 years old before Monday, July 12, 2021 you cannot show in the breed show.**
2. All animals must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming to the entry form on arrival at the show.
3. **All Entries will receive a confirmation, please check it carefully! Changes can be made to the variety, sex, class and ear number prior to the confirmation due date. THERE WIL BE NO CHANGES FOR VARIETY, SEX OR CLASS AFTER THE COMFIRMATION DUE DATE. Ear number changes for animals will be accept the day of the show but must be made PRIOR to the start of the show. No other substitutions will be accepted!**
4. Absolutely no tattooing permitted on the fairgrounds.
5. **LIMIT:** (2) entries per class, per variety, per breed, per exhibitor, including the breed fur classes. (i.e. Exhibitor may enter 2 Blue Dutch Jr Does, 2 Black Dutch Jr Does, etc.). This limit does not include the meat pens and single fryer rabbits. Refer to rule #2 under the rabbit meat pen and single fryer divisions.
6. No more than two (2) cash awards are paid, per class, per exhibitor.
7. SHOWMANSHIP RABBIT MUST BE ONE OF YOUR ENTERED ANIMALS.
8. All classes will be judged to correspond with the A.R.B.A. STANDARD OF PERFECTION.
9. Rabbits (including meat pens and single fryers) **must be owned by the exhibitor for 30 days**. The official ownership date is the date shown on the receipt of sale unless the exhibitor bred the animal.
10. 4-H, FFA, Grange and Independent Exhibitors must abide by the "Small Animal and Rabbit Department General Rules," unless otherwise stated.
11. The class number is determined by age and sex of the animal.
12. Important: Please consult an American Rabbit Breeder's Standard of Perfection for information concerning varieties and appropriate weights for the classes in each breed.
13. This is a one day carry in show. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the show table for judging and must be present when their animal is judged.

# RABBIT MEAT PENS & SINGLE FRYERS

ENTRY FEE: \$3.50 per entry

## NO CASH AWARDS

### **ADDITIONAL RULES FOR MEAT PENS AND SINGLE FRYERS: GENERAL RULES:**

1. This program will be available to all 4-H, FFA and Grange members in the 38<sup>th</sup> District Agricultural area. The animal must be a part of a bona fide market project, which means any member carrying this project must be enrolled in a 4-H or Grange Club, be a member of an FFA Chapter, or be a qualified Independent exhibitor.
2. Limit: Junior Exhibitors will be limited to sale one (1) large animal and one (1) small animal project. Junior Exhibitors can show up to two (2) large market and two (2) small market animals (excluding poultry meat pens). Exhibitors will be able to show two (2) market animals of the same species or one (1) market animal of two different species.
3. Large Market animals consist of Beef, Meat Goats, Sheep and Swine. Small Market animals consist of Rabbit Meat Pens, Single Fryers, Poultry Meat Pens and Market Turkeys.
4. There will be a **7%** selling charge collected on all market rabbits and market poultry, sold to defray expenses of the auction, operations of the sale committee, and to provide a contingency fund required by the state, against possible losses.
5. Junior exhibitors must declare within one hour after the end of the market show for that species in which the exhibitor is showing whether they will consign their animal to the Auction. If the decision is "yes", the animal will be automatically consigned to the Livestock Auction Committee for sale. If the decision is "no", the exhibitor must sign the declaration book in the Sales Office to NOT sell and will be charged a fee of \$50.00 (payable in cash). All market exhibitors are required to sign the declaration book if they will not be selling their animal, and/or if they are showing two market animals. **The 2021 auction is a terminal sale. NO ANIMAL MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM THE AUCTION.**
6. For the purpose of this Small Animal Auction, all Champions so selected are 'REQUIRED' to be consigned to the Auction and offered for sale through the ring.
7. **ALL Group 1 Rabbit Meat Pens and Single Fryers, ALL 4-H & FFA Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Single Fryers and Supreme Champion, Reserve Supreme Champion Meat Pens MUST sell in the 2021 Small Animal Virtual Auction**
8. Exhibitor must be in uniform for weigh-in and judging.
9. See A.R.B.A. rules for meat pen/single fryer guidelines.
10. All state rules apply.

# POULTRY DEPARTMENT

Entries are due no later than Thursday, May 20<sup>th</sup> by 12:00 midnight

## RULES FOR POULTRY DEPARTMENT:

1. **LIMIT:** 2 entries per class, per exhibitor (except meat pens).
2. Because of the need for heightened awareness of poultry biosecurity and recent outbreaks of infectious diseases in the poultry industry, State Poultry Health Guidelines will be strictly adhered to.
3. **All birds including primary will be inspected upon delivery to fair.** All poultry will be inspected in the West Parking Lot prior to being allowed on the fairgrounds. This includes meat pens, turkeys and exhibition birds. Please use the West Parking Lot Gate off Soderquist Road for inspection. Exhibits will then be allowed to enter the fairgrounds as directed by fair staff. **There will be no birds allowed in vehicles or otherwise, on the fairgrounds that have not passed inspection per State Poultry Health Rules.**
4. Any bird exhibiting evidence of disease or presence of external parasites will not be admitted to the fairgrounds.
5. All birds must be carried to the inspector and carry cages are recommended. Birds in free run trailers will not be inspected in the trailer due to safety concerns for the inspector. However, special provisions for free run trailers are available.
6. A judge may excuse a bird from competition if it appears fatigued or out of condition.
7. **All Junior Exhibition and Market Birds & Turkeys must be leg banded** with regulation numbered bands (plastic or metal). Leg bands must be provided by the exhibitor and listed on the entry form. All birds must be banded for the health inspection check. **The Fair does not provide leg bands.**
8. Birds are entered at the owner's risk. Judges and show personnel are not responsible in any way for theft, death or injury to birds. All reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the bird's safety.
9. All birds used in showmanship must be owned by the exhibitor and entered and shown in their appropriate exhibition/meat class.

## ADDITIONAL RULES FOR JUNIOR EXHIBITION POULTRY:

1. Each bird entered must be owned by the exhibitor and be part of project under the care and management of the exhibitor no less than 30 days prior to the opening of the Fair.
2. Junior exhibitors at the fair must prepare for judging and show their own birds. No physical assistance may be given to the exhibitor in the grooming, fitting, and/or showing of any bird by an individual not eligible for the Junior Department. Verbal assistance is acceptable. Violation of this rule may result in disqualification. Judging per APA and/or ABA guidelines.
3. **A judge will only examine and judge a bird that is "Adult feathered and matured" regardless if it meets the age requirements. All birds not deemed "Adult feathered and matured" will be disqualified from the show and not be judged.**
4. **All class 3 & 4 Poultry entries MUST be Adult Feathered & Matured. Since different breeds of poultry mature at different rates, the 5-month age rule is only a guideline.**

### **ADDITIONAL RULES FOR POULTRY MEAT PENS AND MARKET TURKEYS:**

1. LIMIT: Exhibitor can have no more than (4) meat pens (total) with no more than (2) entries per class. Classes will be assigned at weigh in per published class weights.
2. Poultry Meat Pens & Market Turkeys will be weighed in the West Parking Lot, immediately following the Poultry health inspection. All birds must be banded at time of inspection and ownership must be verified. Pen pairs must be brought to the scale in pairs of two.
3. Only birds entered in the show and passing the Health Inspection are allowed on the fairgrounds. See additional Poultry rules.
4. All meat pens must be under 62 days old at judging. Each bird entered must be owned by the exhibitor and be a part of the project under the care and management of the exhibitor within 5 days of hatching.
5. All exhibitors are required to hold their meat pen at the time of judging. Additional holders may be recruited for exhibitors with more than one entry per class.
6. Birds will be inspected and weighed on official fair scales. The Fair will not provide scales for pre-weigh in of meat pens.
7. This program will be available to all 4-H, FFA and Grange members in the 38<sup>th</sup> District Agricultural area. The animal must be a part of a bona fide market project, which means any member carrying this project must be enrolled in a 4-H or Grange Club, be a member of an FFA Chapter, or be a qualified Independent exhibitor.
8. Limit: Junior Exhibitors will be limited to sale one (1) large animal and one (1) small animal project. Junior Exhibitors can show up to two (2) large market and two (2) small market animals (excluding poultry meat pens). Exhibitors will be able to show two (2) market animals of the same species or one (1) market animal of two different species.
9. Large Market animals consist of Beef, Meat Goats, Sheep and Swine. Small Market animals consist of Rabbit Meat Pens, Single Fryers, Poultry Meat Pens and Market Turkeys.
10. There will be a **7%** selling charge collected on all market rabbits and market poultry, sold to defray expenses of the auction, operations of the sale committee, and to provide a contingency fund required by the state, against possible losses.
11. Junior exhibitors must declare within one hour after the end of the market show for that species in which the exhibitor is showing whether they will consign their animal to the Auction. If the decision is "yes", the animal will be automatically consigned to the Livestock Auction Committee for sale. If the decision is "no", the exhibitor must sign the declaration book in the Sales Office to NOT sell and will be charged a fee of \$50.00 (payable in cash). All market exhibitors are required to sign the declaration book if they will not be selling their animal, and/or if they are showing two market animals. **The 2021 auction is a terminal sale. NO ANIMAL MAY BE WITHDRAWN FROM THE AUCTION.**
12. For the purpose of this Small Animal Auction, all Champions so selected are 'REQUIRED' to be consigned to the Auction and offered for sale through the ring.
13. **ALL Group 1 Poultry Meat Pens and Market Turkeys and all 4-H & FFA Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion MUST sell in the 2021 Small Animal Virtual Auction**
14. Exhibitor must be in uniform for weigh-in and judging.
15. All state rules apply.

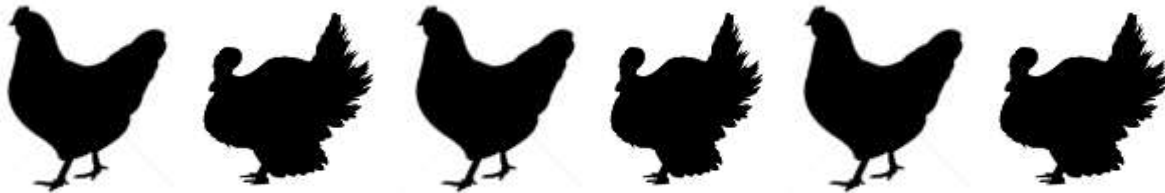

Rules, definitions and judging procedures as described in the latest edition of the Standard of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture. American Rabbit Breeders Association, Eric Stewart, Executive Director, P.O. Box 400, Knox, Pennsylvania 16232. Stanislaus County Fair rules may supersede A.R.B.A. rules where matters of policy or procedures are involved. **A.R.B.A. age rule does apply. If you turn 19 years old before Monday, July 12, 2021 you cannot show in the breed show.** All State and Local Rules apply.
2. All animals must be identified by permanent ear tag conforming to the entry form on arrival at the show. **No substitutions will be allowed except in the same division, class, breed, sex and variety.** Absolutely no ear tagging permitted on the fairgrounds.
3. **LIMIT:** (2) entries per class, per division, per exhibitor. No more than two cash awards will be paid, per class, per exhibitor.
4. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division & class for breed, variety, age, & sex ONLY. If no division is offered, no awards may be made.
5. This is a one day carry in show. Exhibitors are responsible for getting their animals to and from the show table for judging and must be present when their animal is judged.
6. The Stanislaus County Fair is not responsible for loss, death, or injury of any animals. All possible care will be taken to protect all animals.
7. The class number is determined by age and sex of the animal.
